Summary

The fraudulent email comes from an account that claims to be the Microsoft Online Services Team. This email states that the recipient's Office 365 Business Invoice is ready to be paid and is instructed to sign into their portal with the link provided. The page has been taken down by web page developers.

Intent of the Email

The phisher/sender may be attempting to capture account credentials or credit/debit information for their own malicious purposes.
