Summary

The fraudulent email notifies recipients that they will be able to send/receive emails unless they click on a link to visit a site and enter their email login credentials. The link goes to a fraudulent page. This was sent by a compromised CSULB email account and is being addressed accordingly.

Intent of the Email

The sender is attempting to capture personal and account information for their own malicious purposes.

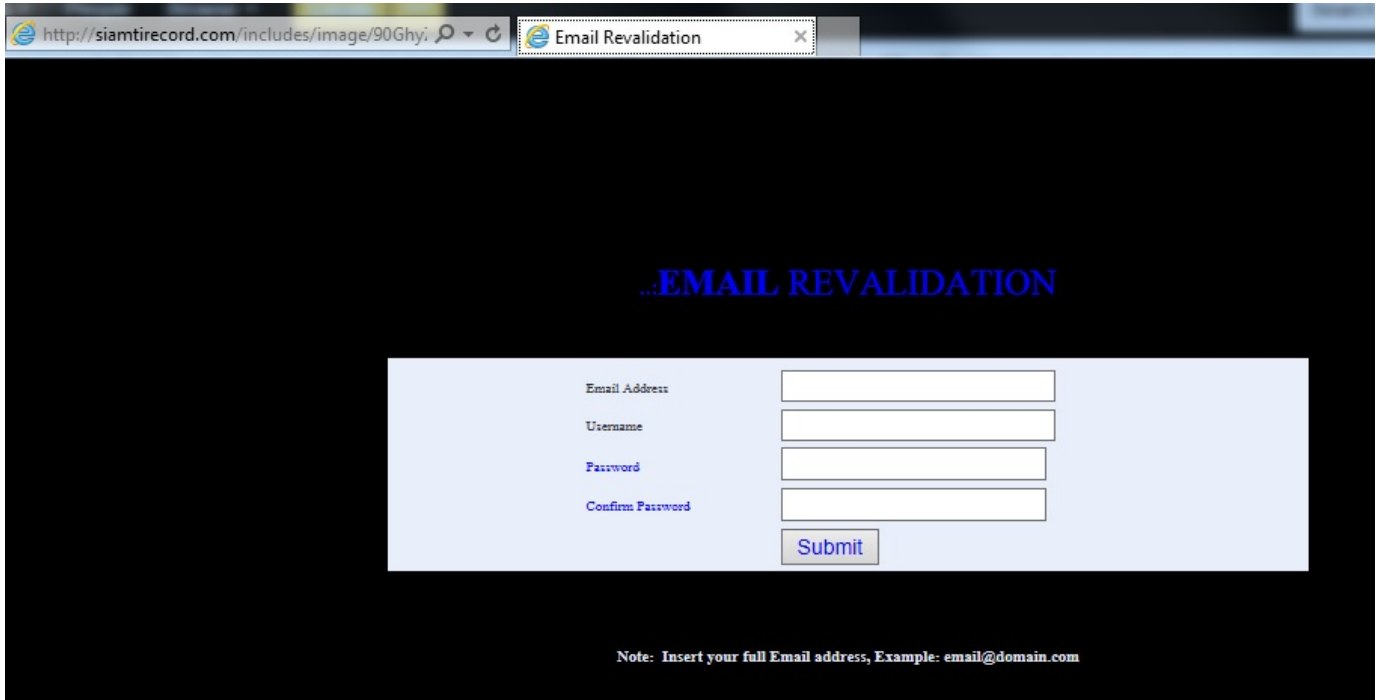


Figure 2: Screenshot of the fake OWA page the phishing email links to
