

# 2015-04-13 Unlimited MB space to your mailbox

This is a phishing attempt first reported to CSULB ITS on **April 13, 2015**.

## Email Detail

**From:** VPN Administrative Support <support@vpn.com>  
**Sent:** Monday, April 13, 2015 11:22 AM  
**Subject:** Unlimited MB space to your mailbox++

## Summary

The user receives a notification that their VPN Email account will expire and must click on a link to upgrade. The link takes the user to a fraudulent website which appears to have been suspended by the website host company.

## Intent of the Email

The sender is attempting to obtain BeachID account credentials for their own malicious purposes.
