This is a phishing attempt first reported to CSULB ITS on **June 11, 2018**.

## Summary

The fraudulent email comes from an account that claims to be from CSULB Mail Support and instructs the recipient to click on a link to access a protected message that requires the User to sign into their email account.

## Intent of the Email

The phisher/sender is attempting to capture email account credentials for their own malicious purposes.
