This is a phishing attempt first reported to CSULB ITS on **July 9, 2018**.

## Summary

The fraudulent email comes from an account that claims to be the Office365 team. The email states that the recipient has requested to have their account removed and is instructed to click on the link provided in the email to cancel the request. The fraudulent webpage is now blocked from being accessed by anyone while on the campus network.

## Intent of the Email

The phisher/sender is attempting to capture email account credentials for their own malicious purposes.
