Summary

The fraudulent email claims that an upgrade to their servers are being initiated. The email also claims that due to the upgrade, all email users are instructed to click on the link provided in the email to keep their account. The fraudulent page has been taken down by the web page developers.

Intent of the Email

The phisher/sender is attempting to capture email account credentials for their own malicious purposes.
