## Summary

The fraudulent email claims to come from the CSULB school account. The recipient is instructed to update their security settings for their school email account with the link provided as it is claimed to be updated. The fraudulent page has been taken down by the web page developers.

## Intent of the Email

The phisher/sender may be attempting to capture email account credentials for their own malicious purposes.
