
## Summary

The user receives a notification that their mailbox is full and to click on a link to upgrade their account. The link takes the user to a fraudulent website which has been reported as abuse to the website host company.

## Intent of the Email

The sender is attempting to obtain BeachID account credentials for their own malicious purposes.

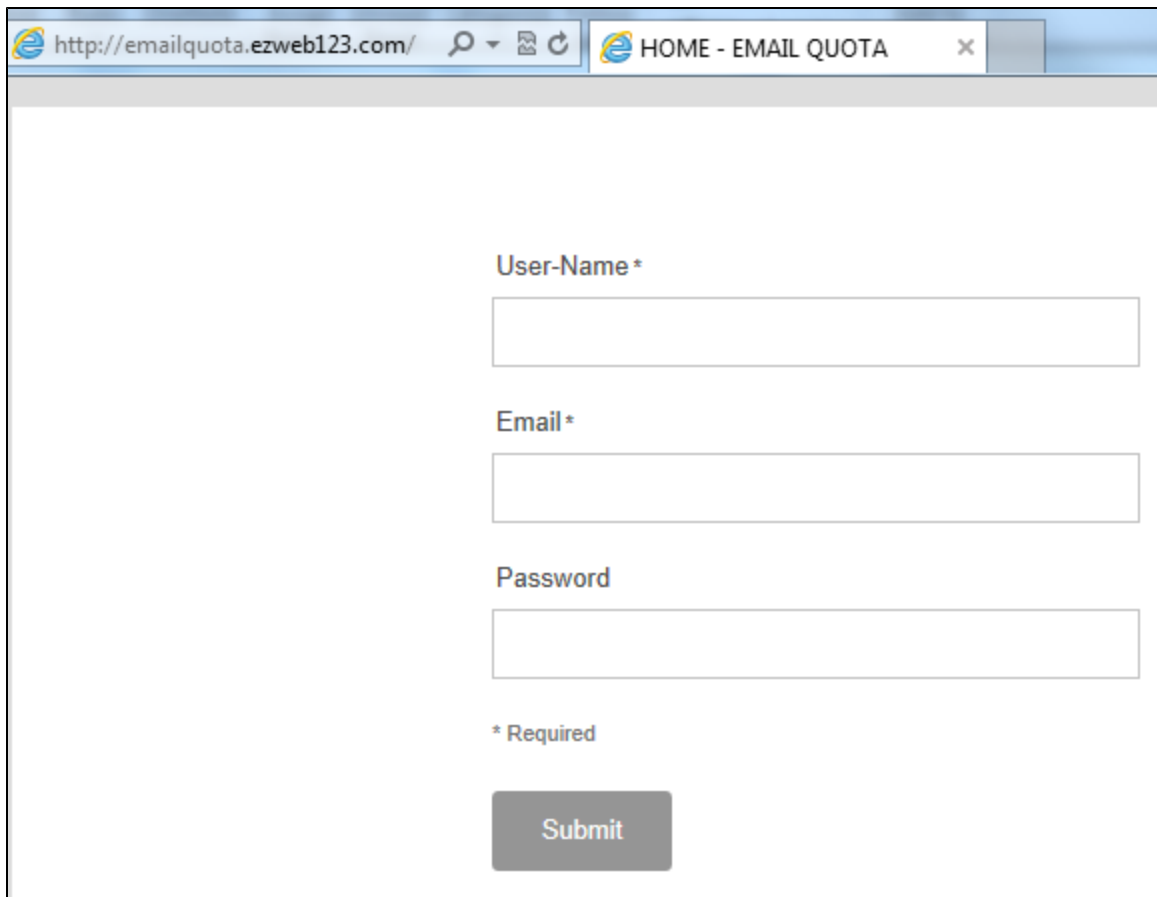


Figure 2: Screenshot of the phishing site attempting to collect BeachID passwords.

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
