This is a phishing attempt first reported to CSULB ITS on **July 11, 2018**.

Summary

The fraudulent email comes from an account that claims to be the Office365 team. The email states that the recipient must confirm their password to avoid an account suspension and is instructed to click on the link provided in the fraudulent email. The fraudulent site has been taken down by the web page developers.

Intent of the Email

The phisher/sender is attempting to capture email account credentials for their own malicious purposes.
