## Summary

The fraudulent email request recipients to click on the link that claims to recover their email account. The link opens up to a fraudulent login page.

### Intent of the Email

This is an attempt to acquire personal account credentials or to install malware on your device by downloading a file.

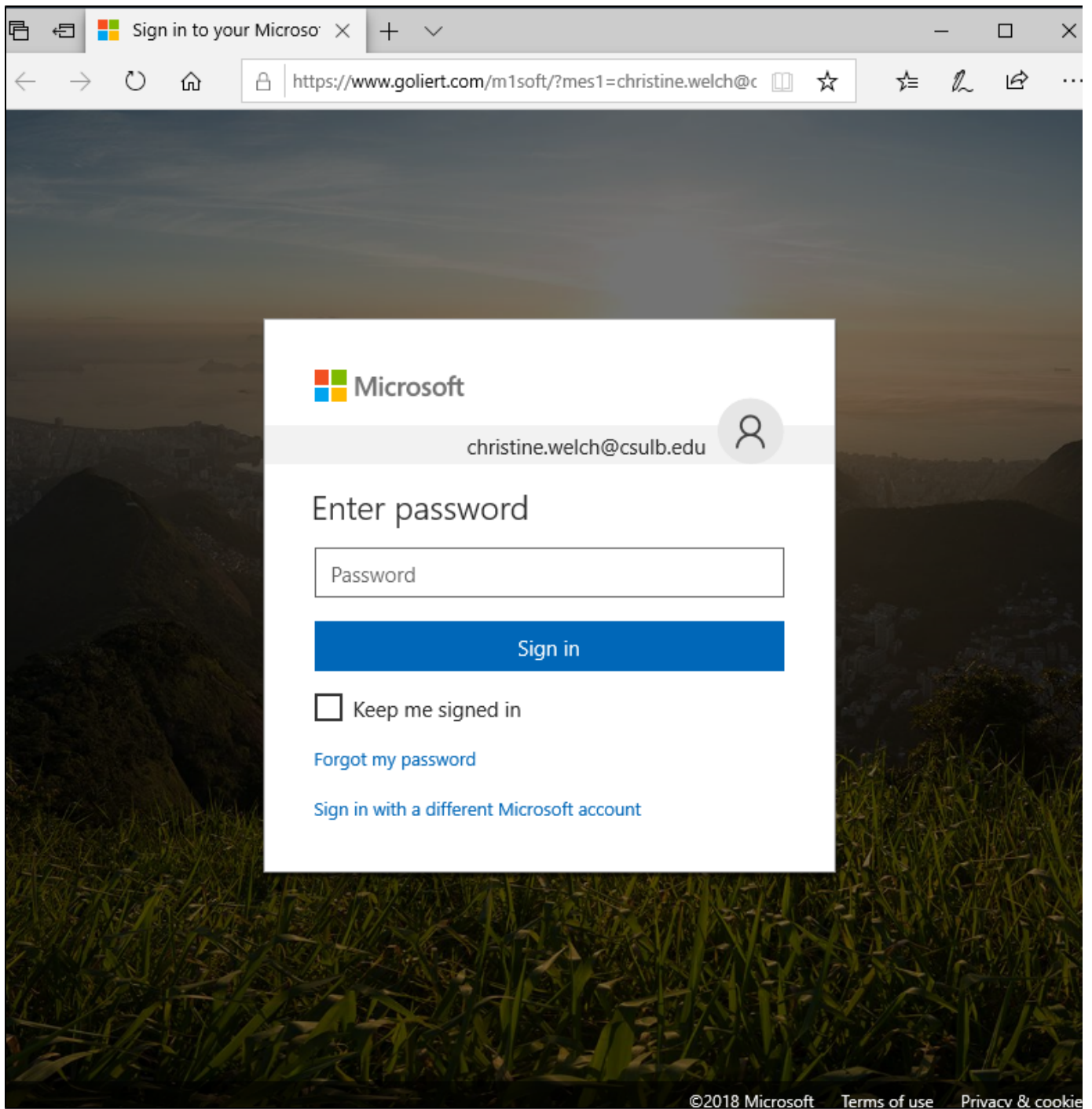


Figure 2: Screenshot of the fraudulent phishing page
