Summary

The fraudulent email comes from CSULB accounts that are known to have been compromised. The recipient is instructed to click on the link provided in the email to access a document that requires their e-signature.

Intent of the Email

The phisher/sender is attempting to capture account credentials for their own malicious purposes.
