This is a phishing attempt first reported to CSULB ITS on **August 7, 2018**.

## Summary

The fraudulent email states that the recipient's email account is out-of-date and is instructed to click on the link provided in the email within 12 hours to prevent their account from being deactivated.

## Intent of the Email

The phisher/sender is attempting to capture email account credentials for their own malicious purposes.

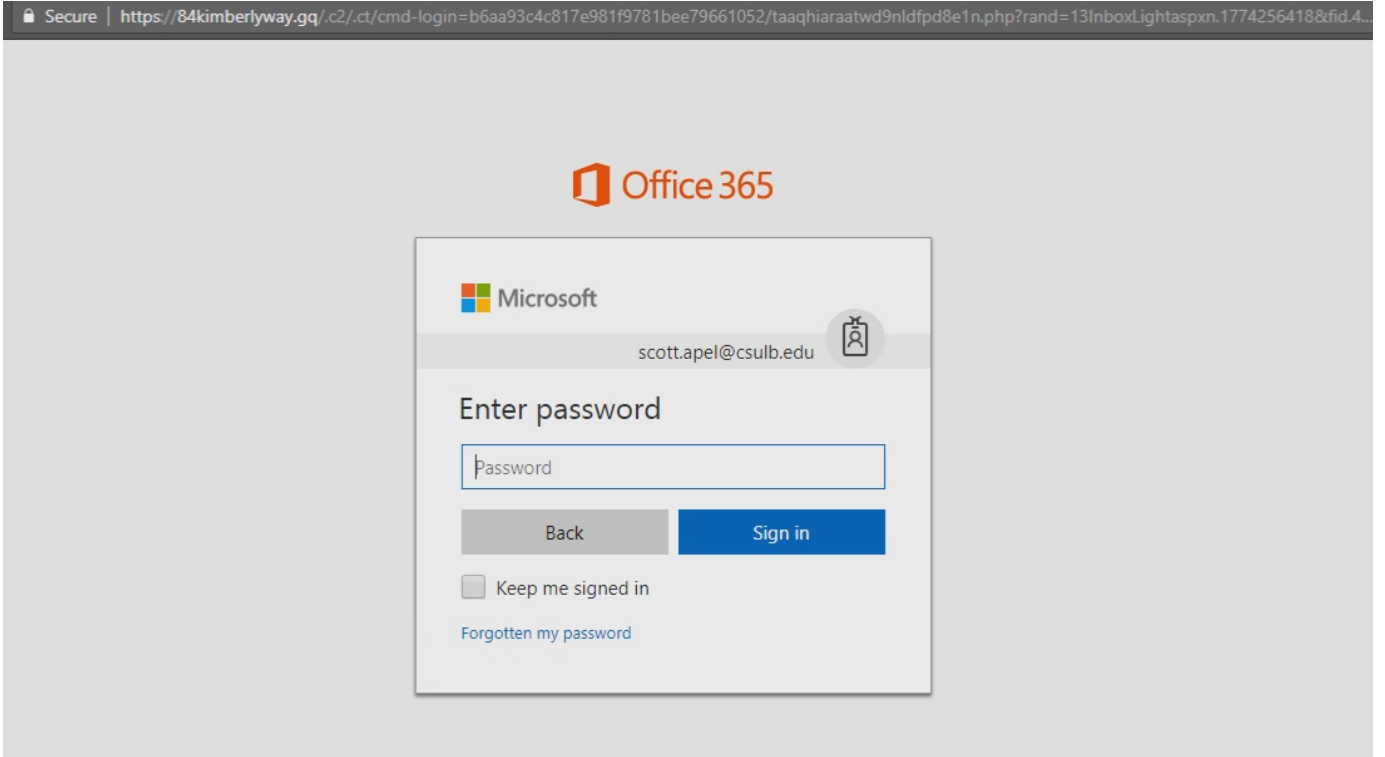


Figure 2: Screenshot of the phishing page
