Summary

The fraudulent email notifies recipients that their CSULB email has been disabled due to unusual activity. It directs recipients to click on a link to verify the account. The phishing site has been reported to the web host company (Weebly.com) as abuse and has since been removed.

Intent of the Email

The sender is attempting to collect CSULB account and password information for their own malicious purposes.
