
## Summary

Email informs recipients that their password will expire and account will be suspended if they do not click on the link provided to update the account. Information Technology Services has reported the phishing website to the website host, which has now been suspended.

## Intent of the Email

The sender is intending to obtain personal account information for their own malicious purposes.
